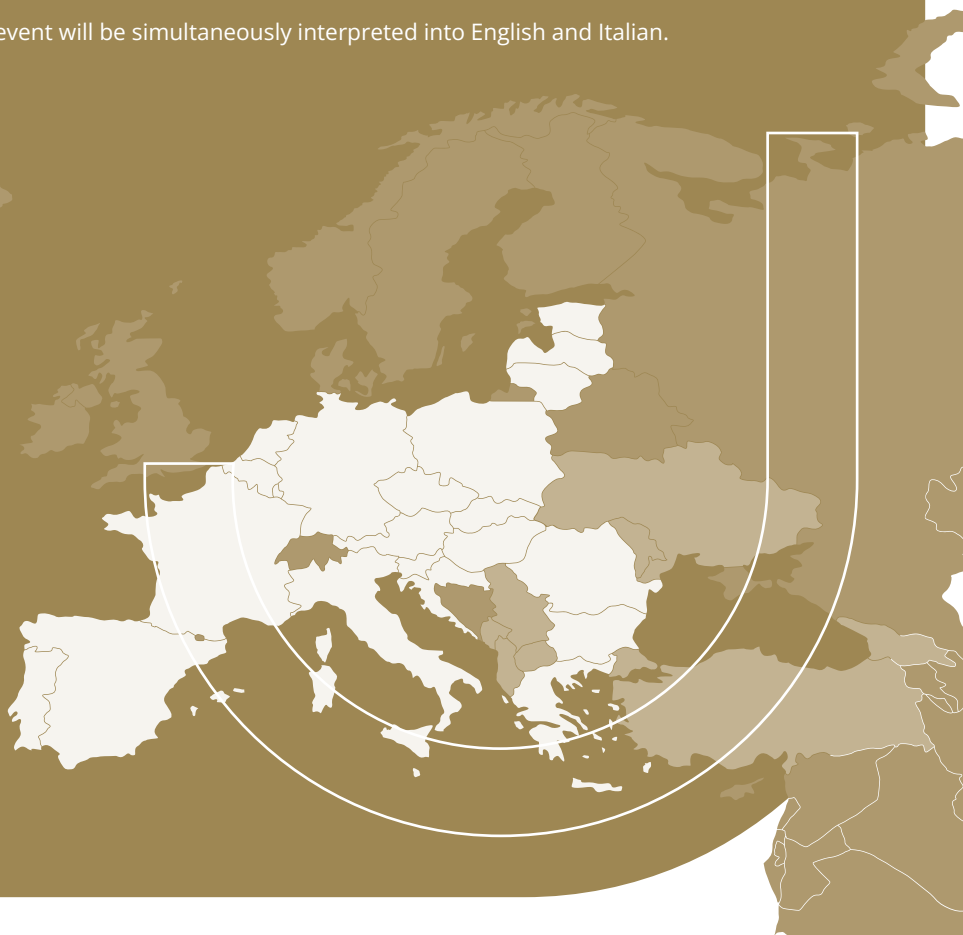

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The EU-financed project Justice Without Litigation II (JuWiLi II) is a large-scale EU-funded project which addresses the current trend in a growing number of Member States to modernise their civil justice systems by transferring non-contentious tasks from the judiciary to other entities, such as notaries. By bringing together 29 organisations from 22 EU Member States the project further develops effective people-centred-justice solutions and aims at strengthening procedural standards as well as the rule of law. It seeks to develop strategies to unburden justice systems and to facilitate access to non-contentious procedures for EU citizens.



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
