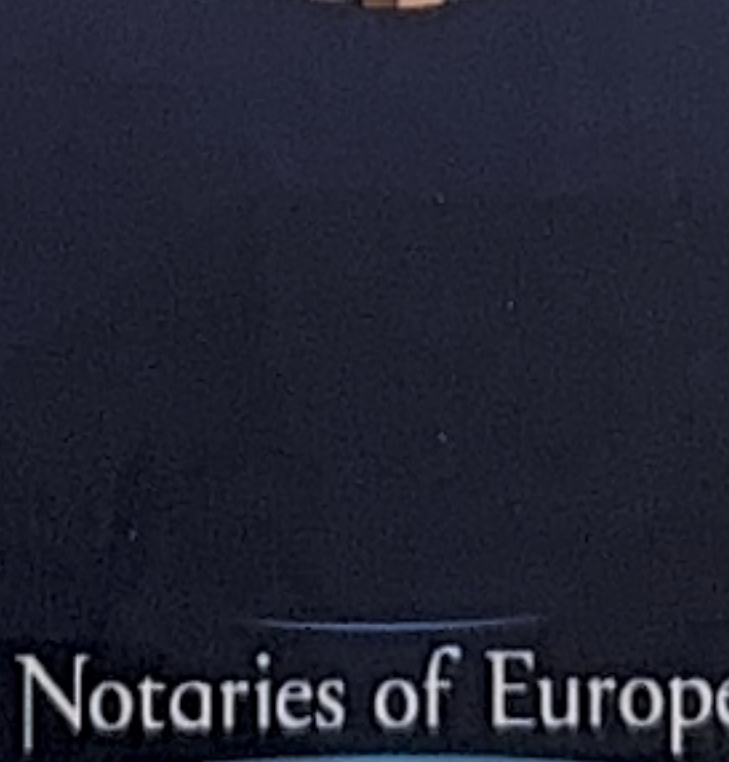
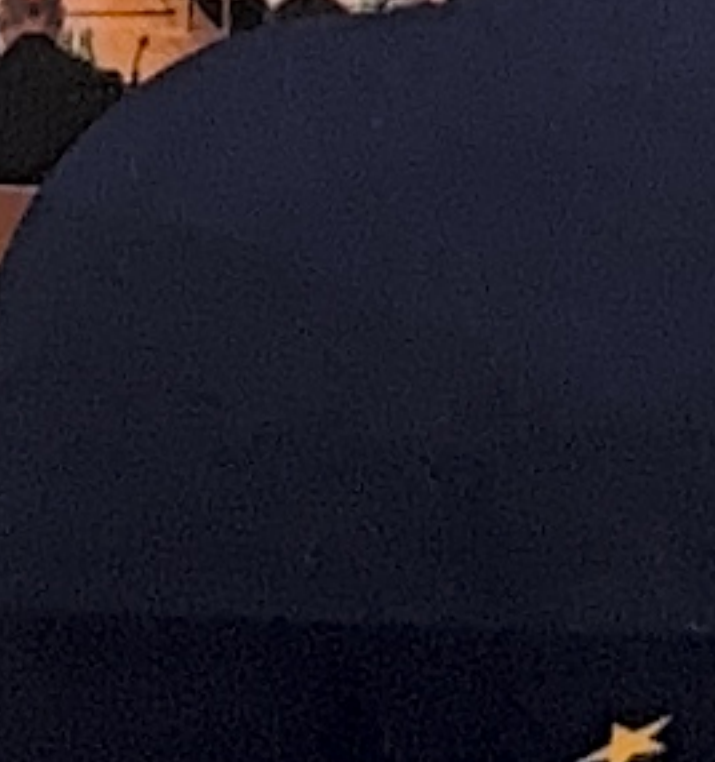
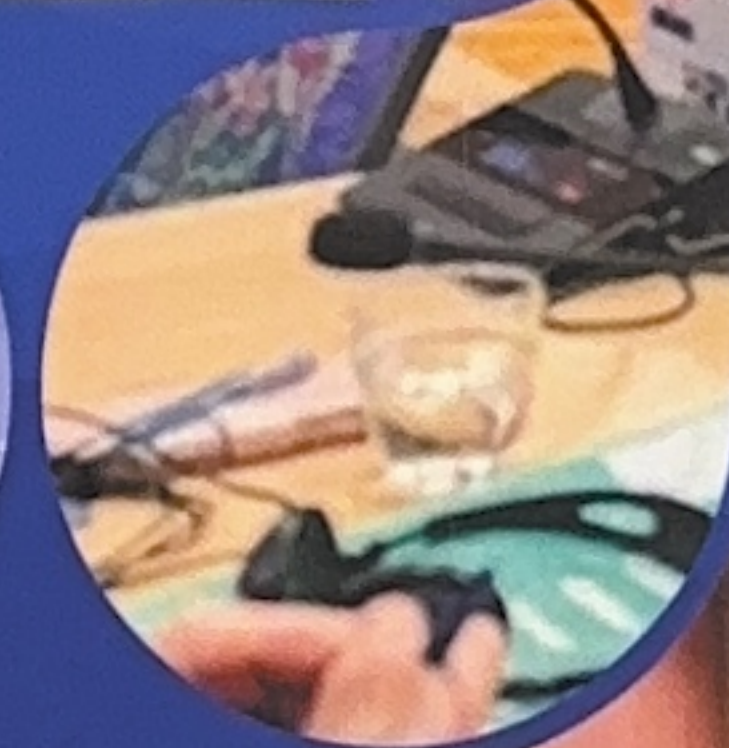
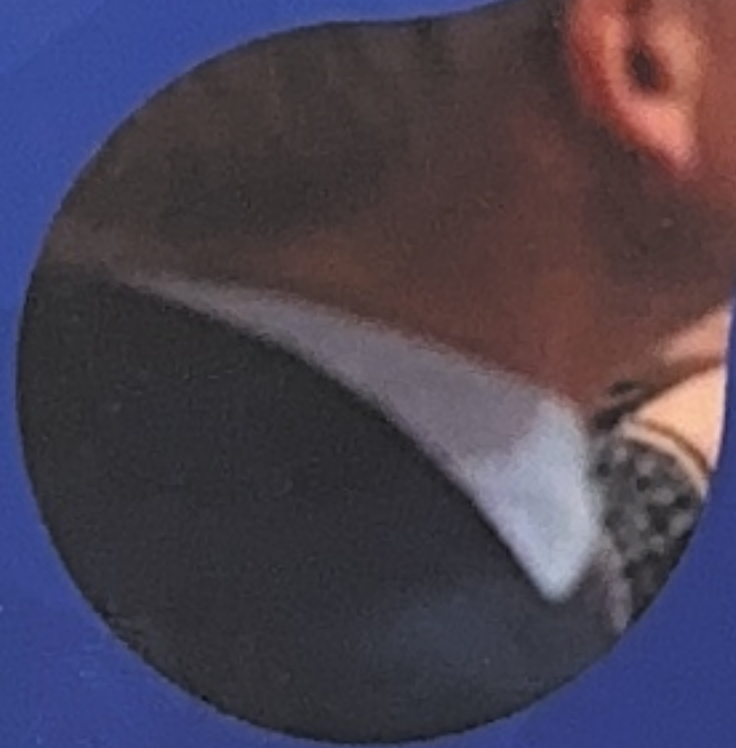
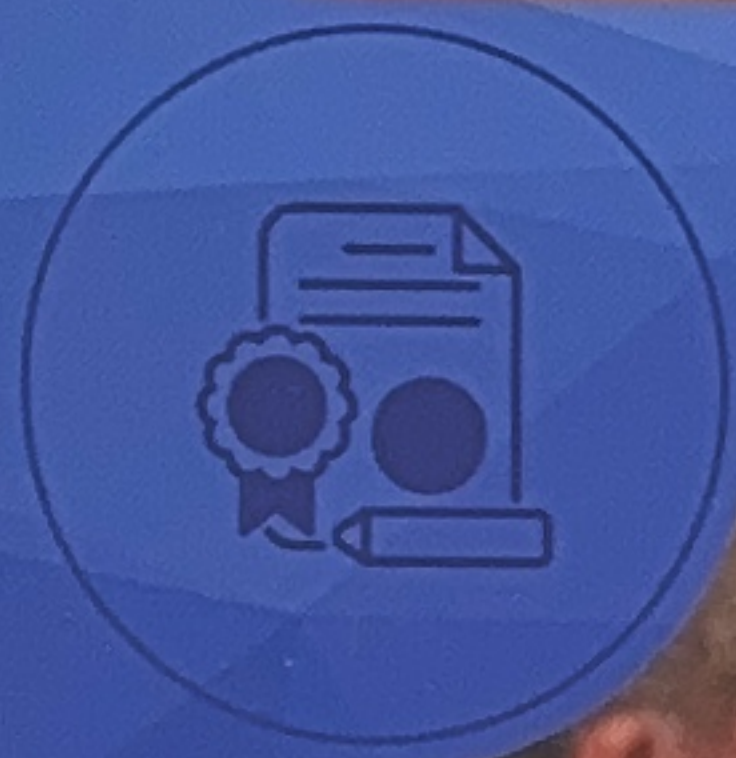


ANNUAL REPORT NOTARIES OF EUROPE

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LAUNCH OF THE JUWILI II PROJECT

24 January 2025

On 24 January 2025, the Austrian notariat hosted the kick-off meeting of the JuWiLi II (Justice Without Litigation for Europe II) project in Vienna. This ambitious project, coordinated by the Austrian notariat and co-financed by the European Union, is a continuation of the first JuWiLi project (2020-2022).

The objective of JuWiLi II is to strengthen judicial cooperation in civil and commercial matters within the European Union, by transferring certain non-contentious judicial procedures to non-judicial players, such as notaries. The project highlights the growing role played by notaries in key areas, such as succession matters, divorce, parental responsibility and the protection of adults.

The JuWiLi II project foresees several concrete results:

- An in-depth analysis of the legal systems of the EU Member States, with a focus on the judicial functions performed by notaries;
- The creation of best practices models for non-contentious procedures;
- An innovative economic study demonstrating the benefits of outsourcing these procedures;
- Policy recommendations to better integrate the judicial activities of notaries into the EU legal framework.

The CNUE plays a central role in this project. In particular, it will develop online communication and cooperation tools, while offering training resources for notaries in the 22 participating Member States.

At the kick-off meeting, the President of the CNUE, Ms. Cosita Delvaux, said: *"I am convinced that JuWiLi II represents a unique opportunity to strengthen the role of notaries in access to justice in the European Union. This project is not limited to refining existing practices – it is about shaping the future of non-contentious justice in Europe".*

On 10 and 11 July in Berlin and on 27 and 28 November in Ljubljana, project partners met to take stock of progress, exchange best practices and strengthen European cooperation.
